Wine Description

This boutique wine is a classic example of Sauvignon Blanc offering intense fruit flavours, including lychees, melon and a hint of grapefruit.

Region Description

The Central Valley (El Valle Central) of Chile is one of the most important wine-producing areas in South America in terms of volume. It is also one of the largest wine regions, stretching from the Maipo Valley (just south of Santiago) to the southern end of the Maule Valley. This is a distance of almost 250 miles (400km) and covers a number of climate types.

The valley offers ideal climate and soil conditions for the growing of grapes and this estate uses prephylloxera vines.

Food Pairing:

This fresh and fruity wine makes the perfect accompaniment to shellfish or light fish dishes. Because of its herby characteristics, it can match well with light dishes with green herbs, also salads or softer more sour cheeses such as goat's cheese.
