Wine Description

The Pfälzer Portugieser shines ruby red. Its fragrance is already very aromatic. Ripe plums, pepper and a mixture of dark berries flow into the nose. In the taste, the red wine is aromatic, spicy and very concentrated. The aromas are powerful and very fruity. One third of the grape juice was drawn off immediately after harvest. During maceration, the remaining must was able to extract the complete essence and flavour from the grapes in a much more concentrated way.

Region Description

Germany's biggest wine region is a charming landscape of orchards, hills, and vineyards, producing some of the country's most interesting wines. Located just south of Frankfurt and north of Alsace, Pfalz enjoys more sun and less rain than anywhere else in Germany, making it well-suited to the rising popularity of red wines throughout the country.

Tastes very good with sauerbraten, wild boar goulash or matured Gouda.
