Region Description

With 23,000 hectares of vineyards, it is the second largest wine-growing region in Germany.

Between Bockenheim and Schweigen, 130 wine villages are linked along 85 kilometres.

With more than 5,000 hectares of vineyards, Riesling is the undisputed number one.

With the tangy, fresh Weißherbsts from the Portugieser grape and the fruity Spätburgunder, red wines are becoming increasingly important in the Palatinate. 40 percent of the vines now bear red grapes, making the Palatinate Germany's largest red wine region.
