Wine Description

The scent of ripe peach so typical of Riesling is easy to discover. Citrus notes and an elegant minerality also characterize the aroma. The acidity has a refreshing effect and completes the impression of a very classic Riesling. A wine with an excellent structure with good maturing potential.

Region Description

Burg Layen is a village in the Nahe situated in the municipality of Rummelsheim, in the Trollbach valley around 3 miles west of the Nahe river. The vineyards here cover around 114 hectares (282 acres), 77 percent of which is planted to white grape varieties. It grows a broad selection of grape varieties within its vineyards, but the most prestigious wines are made from Riesling.

Food Pairing:

We loved the wine together with monkfish medallions with porcini mushrooms and a Riesling sauce.
