Region Description

With its 120,000 hectares of vineyards, Bordeaux is the largest closed wine-growing region in the world. Around 3,000 wineries produce around 5.5 million hectolitres of wine a year.

The climate is influenced by the Atlantic and is mild and balanced. It is typical for Bordeaux that spring is humid, the summer months are sunny, autumn is dry and winter is frost-free.

In Bordeaux, wine is typically a cuvée of different varieties. 85% of the vineyard area is occupied by red wine varieties, as it is a typical red wine region.
