Wine Description

The wine is described as dry, meaning that it contains little to no residual sugar. This allows the fruit and acidity to be more pronounced in the wine. The wine is also described as having a pale to medium gold colour, with aromas of stone fruits, citrus, and tropical fruits. On the palate, it has a smooth acidity with flavours of peach, apricot, green apple, and a hint of spice.

Region Description

Grauburgunder Dunántúli (translating to "Danubian Hills Pinot Gris") is a dry white wine produced in Hungary. The grape variety is Pinot Gris, which is known for its light-bodied, crisp, and fruity character. It is commonly found in Germany or the Alsace region of France, but is also grown in many other wine-growing regions around the world.
