Wine Description

Sought after cherry aromas, notes of forest berries, and red currants characterize the bouquet. These fruit aromas persist in the mouth. Together with the full-bodied sweetness, it results in a rounded wine with notes of jam. Despite its youth, the wine is already very pleasant and can be enjoyed without further cellaring.

Region Description

The Blaufränkisch grape variety – also known as Kékfrankos in Hungary – is a grape variety with a long winemaking tradition. The 2020 harvest is characterised by the excellent health of the grapes which has given a wine with crystal-clear aromas.

Food Pairing:

Try serving it chilled with spicy foods, fruit desserts or soft cheeses.
