Wine Description

The classic Vino Nobile di Montepulciano impresses with its intense bouquet of red fruits, tobacco and vanilla. The taste is dense, structured and shows a balanced, smooth aftertaste of soft tannins and rich aromas of cherries and plum. A noble wine in name and, in fact, the fruit of the finest Tuscan tradition. Intense, full-bodied and rounded, a red wine to enjoy without haste, perhaps on a special occasion.

Region Description

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano is one of Italy's classic red wines produced from Sangiovese and has unquestionably helped Tuscany retain its privileged place on the world wine map.

The highly acclaimed DOCG vineyards surround Montepulciano, a picturesque hill town 40 kilometers (25 miles) southeast of Siena, southeastern Tuscany. The area is made up of slopes reaching 250 to 600 meters (820-1968ft) in altitude, located between two rivers: the Ocria and the Chiana.
