Wine Description

A South French wine with charm that makes you want more! Notes of wild berries, plums and fine spicy nuances beguile the nose. On the palate, the Roche de Pierre is extremely juicy, multifaceted and powerful. The finish is characterised by soft tannins and a pleasant residual sweetness. Tip: Friends of somewhat drier wines can be easily won over if the Roche de Pierre is enjoyed a little cooler.

Region Description

The Languedoc-Roussillon is a seemingly endless landscape formation. The wine-growing region in southern France begins in Nîmes in the east and ends at the Spanish border in the west. It is home to almost half of France's total vineyard area. The Mediterranean microclimate, the many hours of sunshine and the cooling oceanic influence nuance the richness of these wines. Terroir-accentuated wines from granite stone are complex and powerful. Vines rooted in deep slate plateaus beguile with spicy aromas in the glass. And the wines grown on limestone or sandy gravel are palatable, fruity and simply indispensable.

Food Pairing:

Goes well with fresh mushrooms, wild fowl and juicy roasts of veal, pork or lamb or with mild cheese.
