## Wine Description

A rich medium-bodied Australian Shiraz made in a traditional 'hermitage' style that appeals to all wine lovers.

This wine has a delicate soft tannin structure with concentrated flavours and aromas of blackberry, plum, black cherry, chocolate, espresso and black pepper which are all complemented by a hint of vanilla spice from the oak aging.

## Region Description

It is the flagship grape variety of Australia and thus is most widely planted in the country's famous wine regions.

## Food Pairing:

A wine to be enjoyed now, served with traditional beef dishes, rack of lamb with roasted vegetables or a decent aged cheddar.
