Made from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz, producing an intense compact concentrated wine, with luscious, long, warm and spicy fruit flavours, and lingering aftertaste.

Region Description

Cabernet Sauvignon - Syrah blended wines are a particular speciality of Australia, where Syrah is known as Shiraz. The two are well-known French varieties that have been successfully transplanted down under: Cabernet Sauvignon is best known for its role in Bordeaux, while Syrah climbs the steep slopes of the Rhone Valley. In Australia, the two combine (sometimes along with Cabernet Franc) to make a rich, full-bodied red that is the basis of some of the country's most famous wines.

Mount Leonard, situated just outside of Cessnock in the famous Pokolbin Parish of the Lower Hunter Valley in South Eastern Australia, is our flagship Australian Wine.
